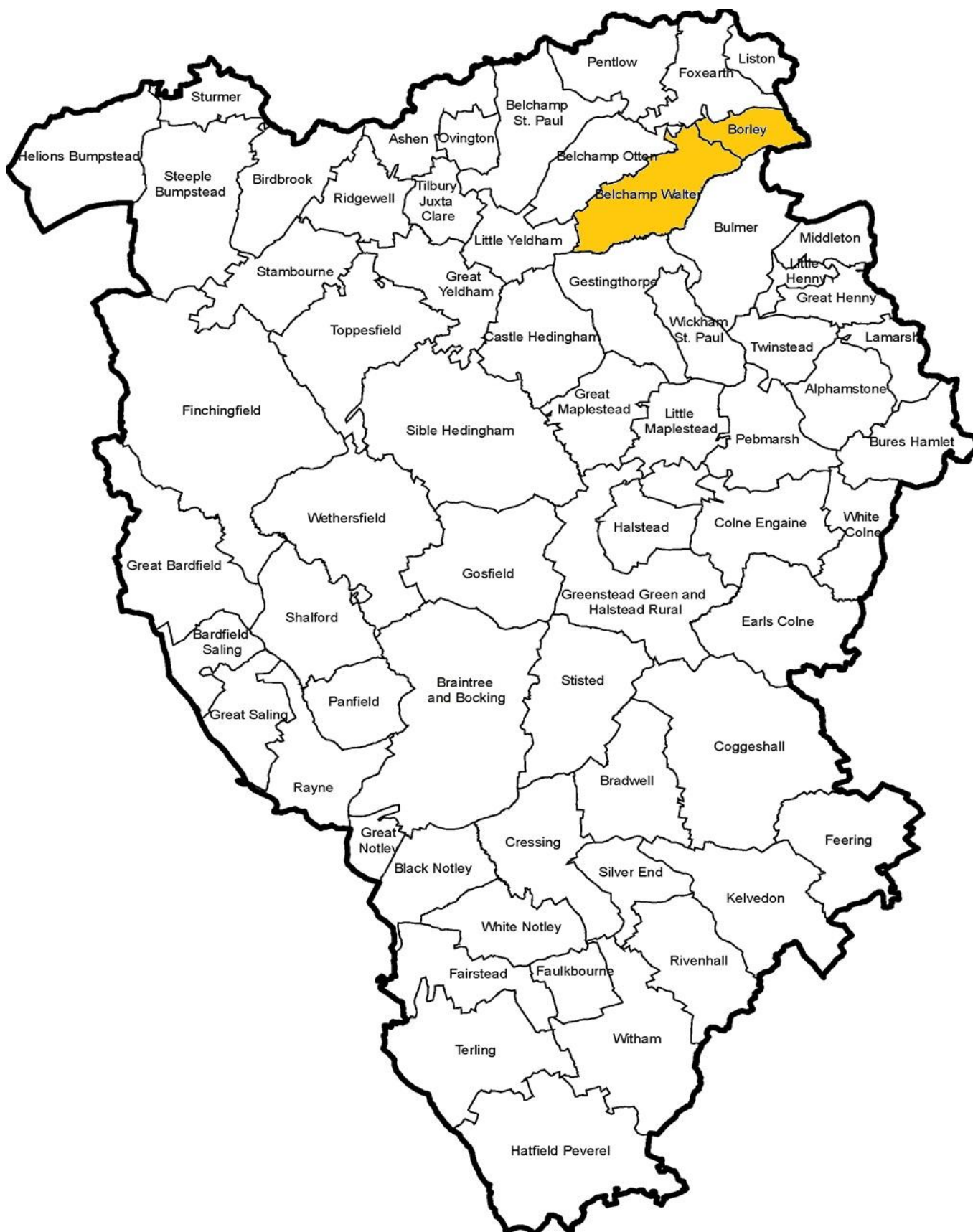

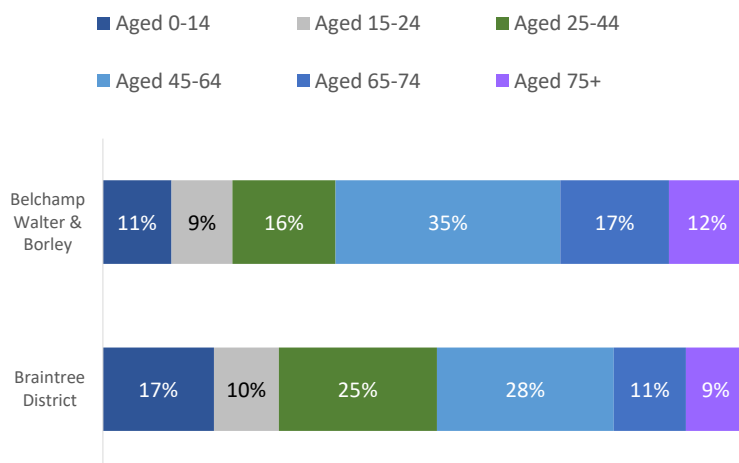

43.2% of households in Belchamp Walter & Borley are economically inactive, which is higher than the 36.9% across the district.

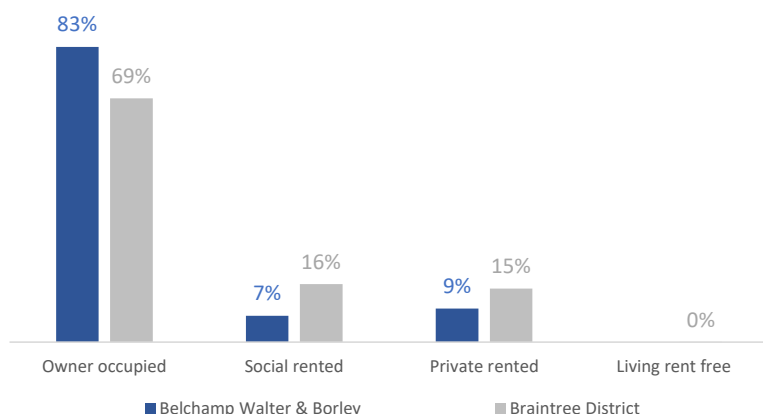


32.2% of households in Belchamp Walter & Borley are couples without children, which is higher than the 18.6% across the district.



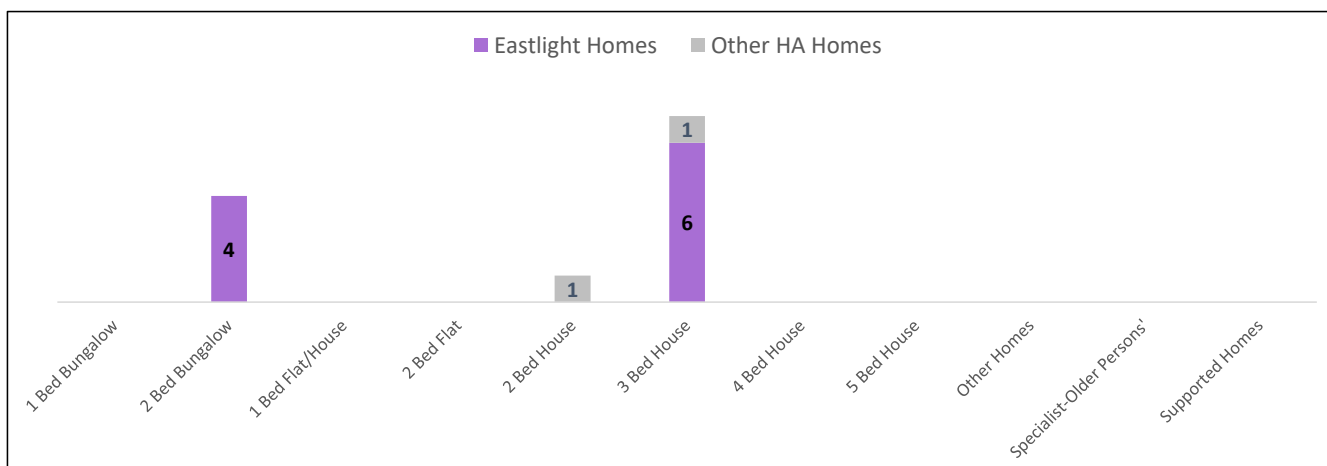
6.8% of households in Belchamp Walter & Borley are one person households aged 65yrs & under, which is lower than the 14.1% across the district.

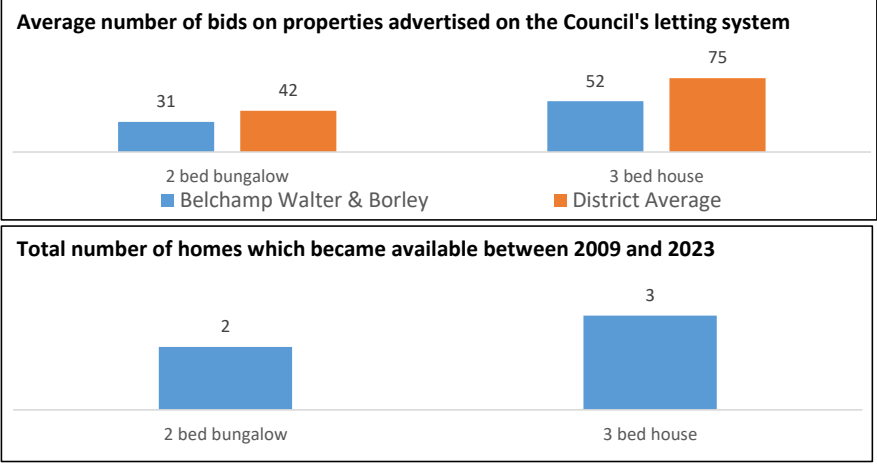
Number of homes which have become available to rent

Applicants waiting for a housing association home to rent

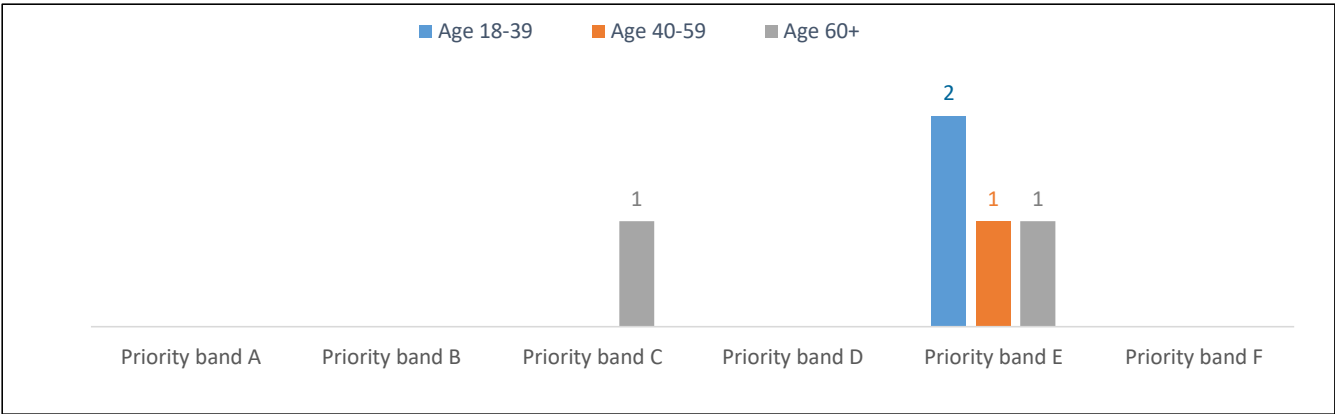
