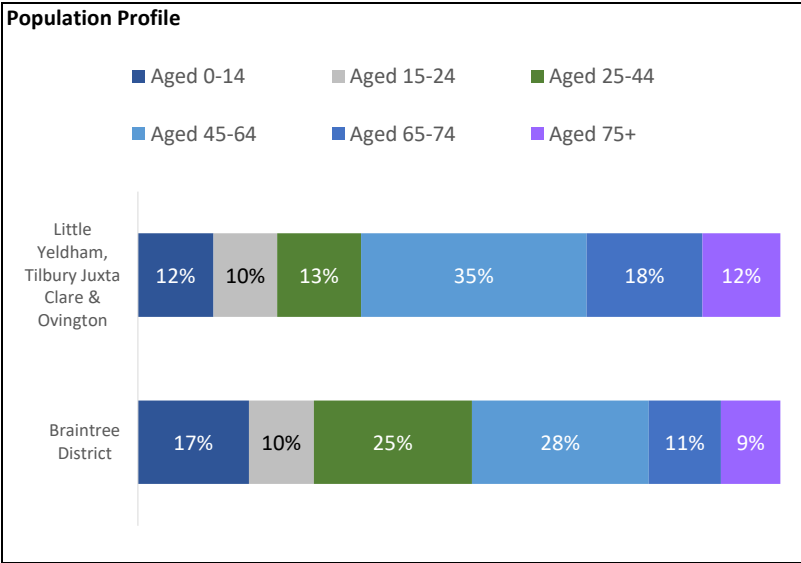

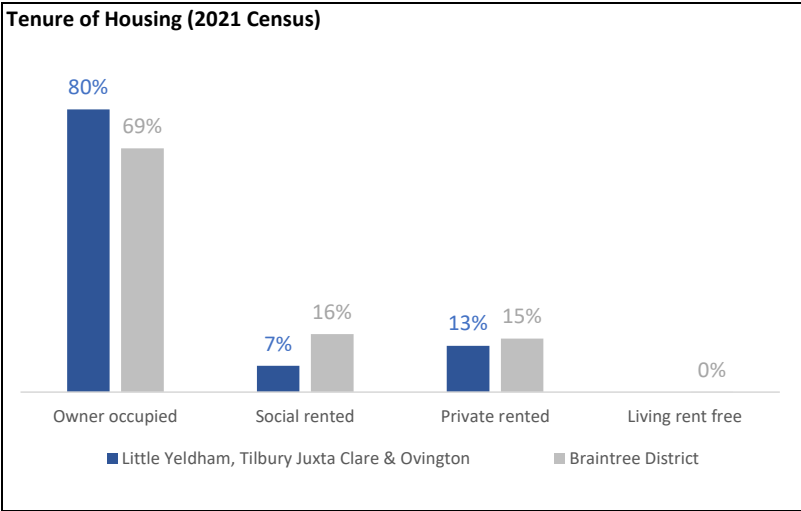
Key Parish Statistics

- Population (2021 Census) - 544
- Households (2021 Census) - 230
- The population is 0.4% of the total Braintree District population (131,464)

45.4% of households in Little Yeldham, Tilbury Juxta Clare & Ovington are economically inactive, which is higher than the 36.9% across the district.

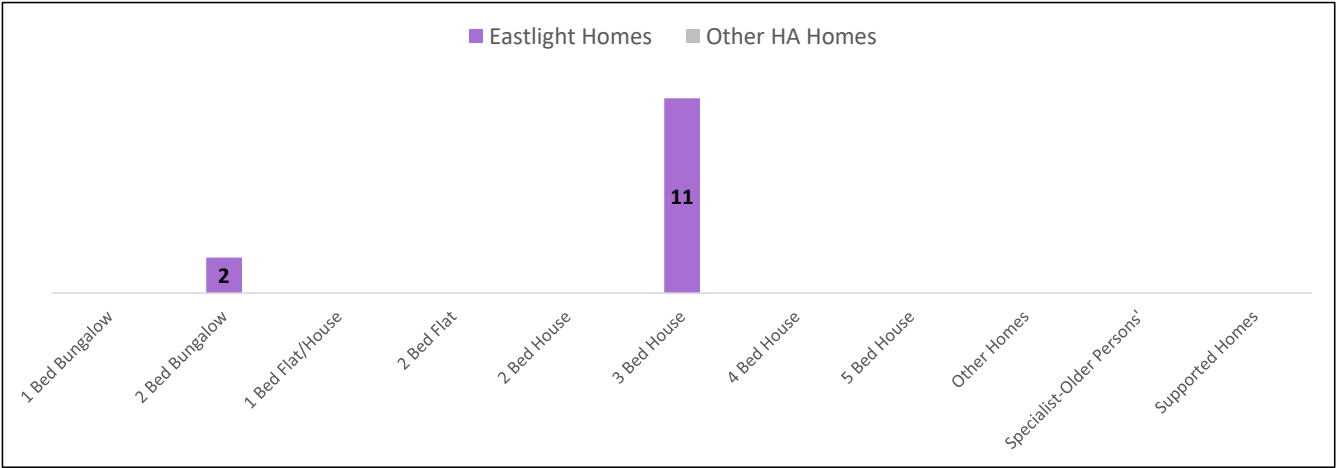
19.5% of households in Little Yeldham, Tilbury Juxta Clare & Ovington are family households all aged over 65yrs, which is higher than the 10.9% across the district.

5.9% of households in Little Yeldham, Tilbury Juxta Clare & Ovington are one person households aged 65yrs & under, which is lower than the 14.1% across the district.

Lettings history in Little Yeldham, Tilbury Juxta Clare & Ovington

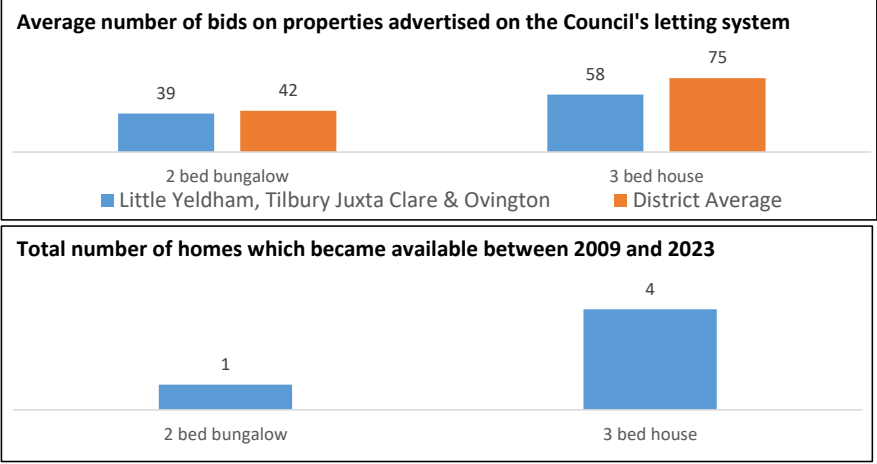
Number of homes which have become available to rent

Applicants waiting for a housing association home to rent

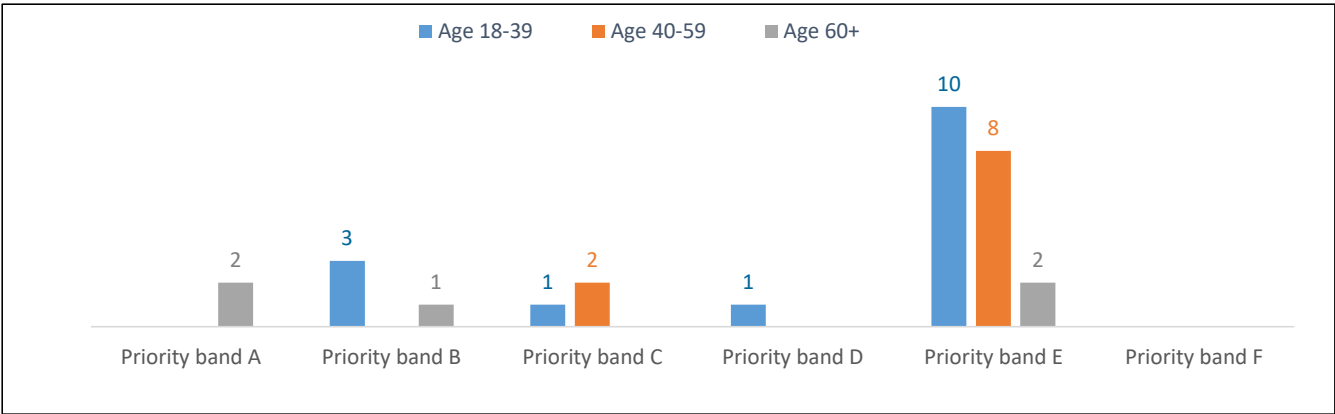
