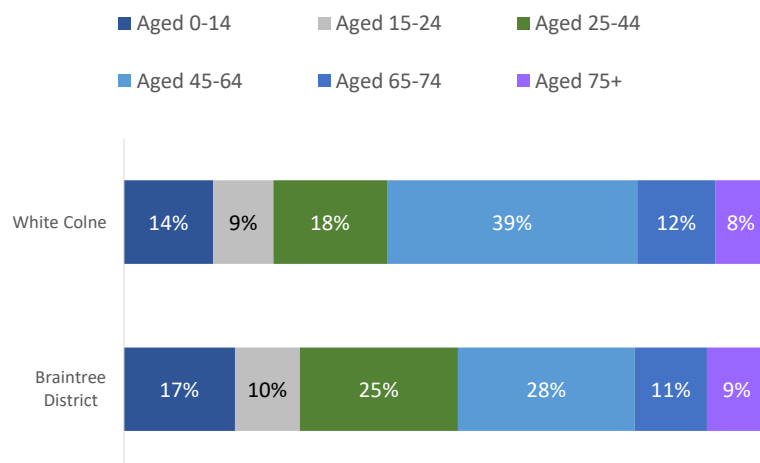

65.4% of households in White Colne are economically active excluding students, which is higher than the 61.1% across the district.

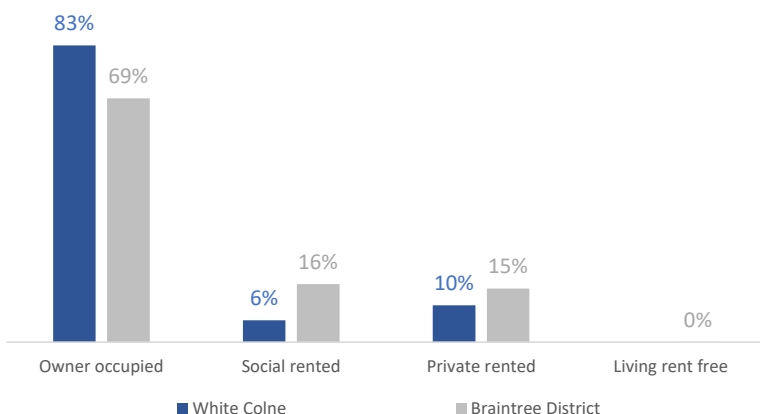


16.9% of households in White Colne are one person households over 65yrs, which is higher than the 13.2% across the district.



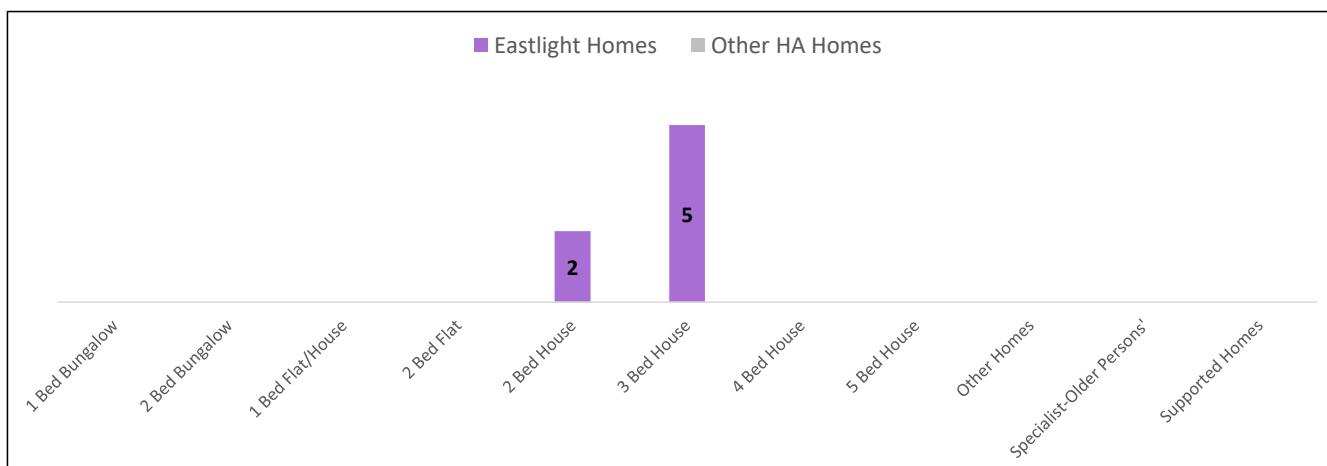
5.2% of households in White Colne are lone parent families, which is lower than the 9.8% across the district.

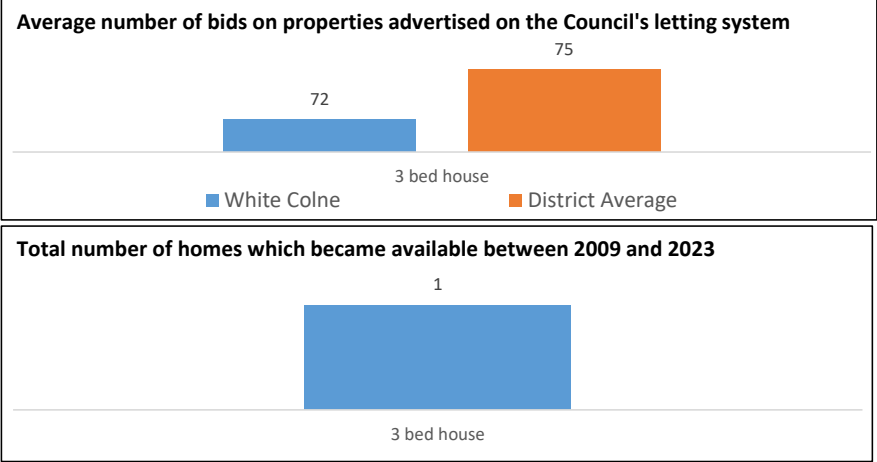

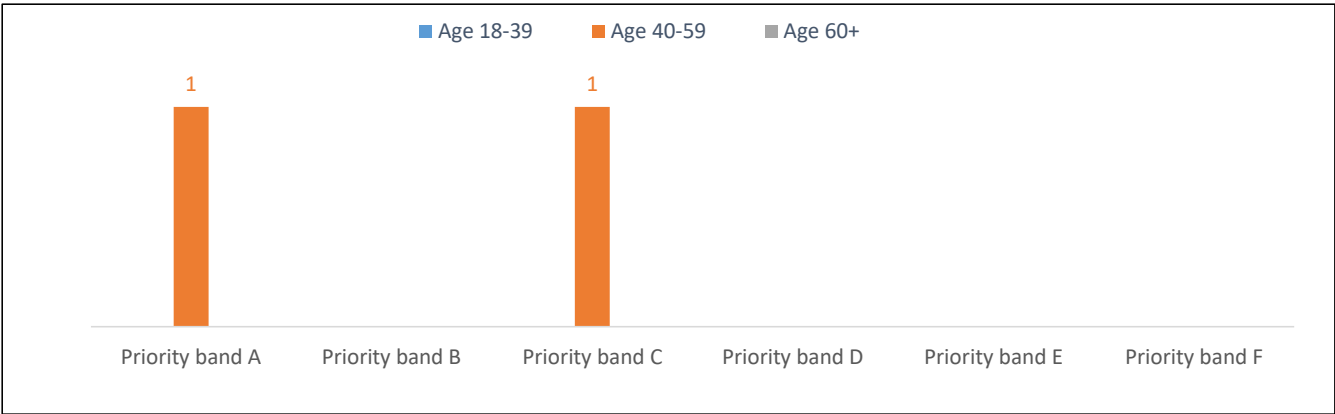
