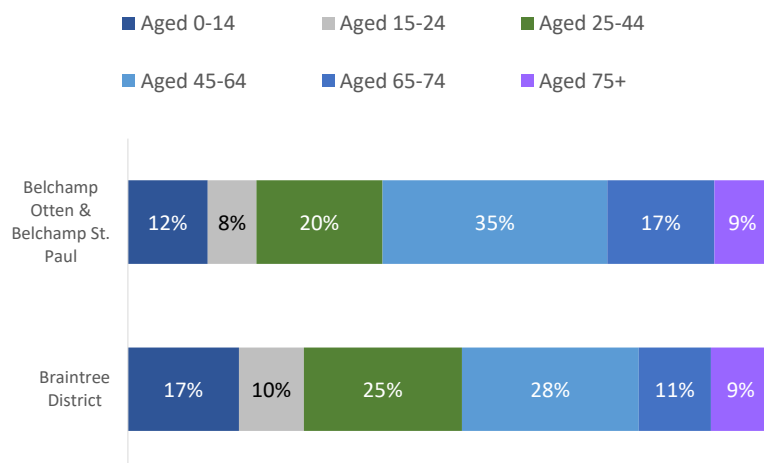

38.8% of households in Belchamp Otten & Belchamp St. Paul are economically inactive, which is higher than the 36.9% across the district.

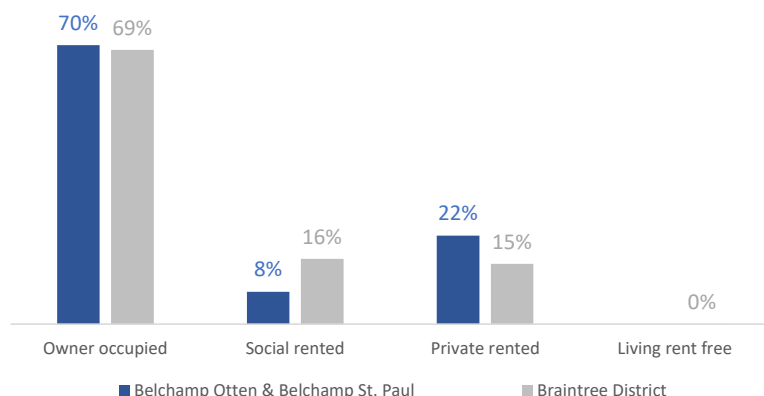


30.7% of households in Belchamp Otten & Belchamp St. Paul are couples without children, which is higher than the 18.6% across the district.



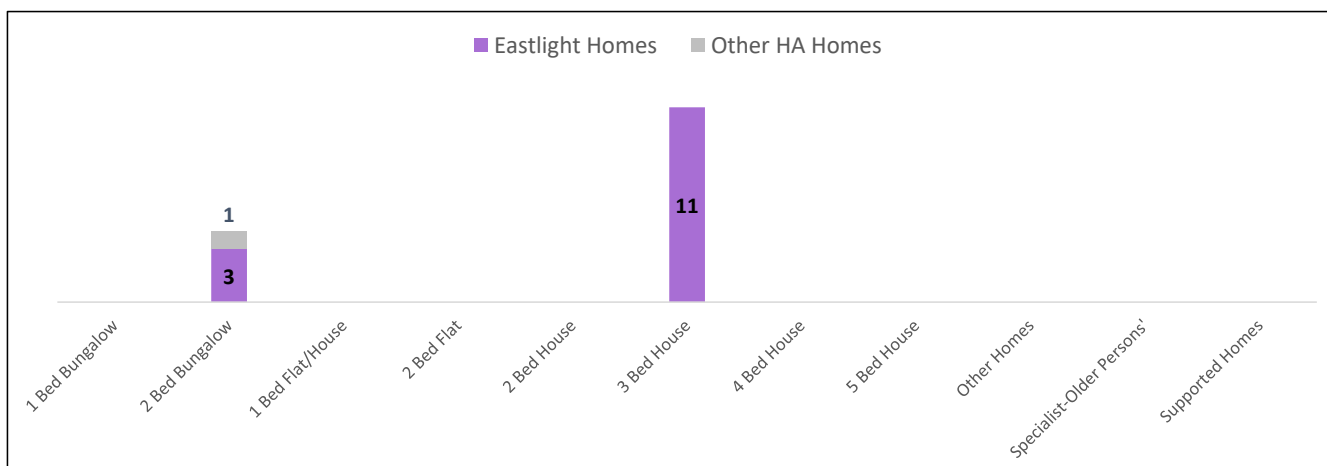
9.1% of households in Belchamp Otten & Belchamp St. Paul are one person households aged 65yrs & under, which is lower than the 14.1% across the district.

Tenure of Housing (2021 Census)

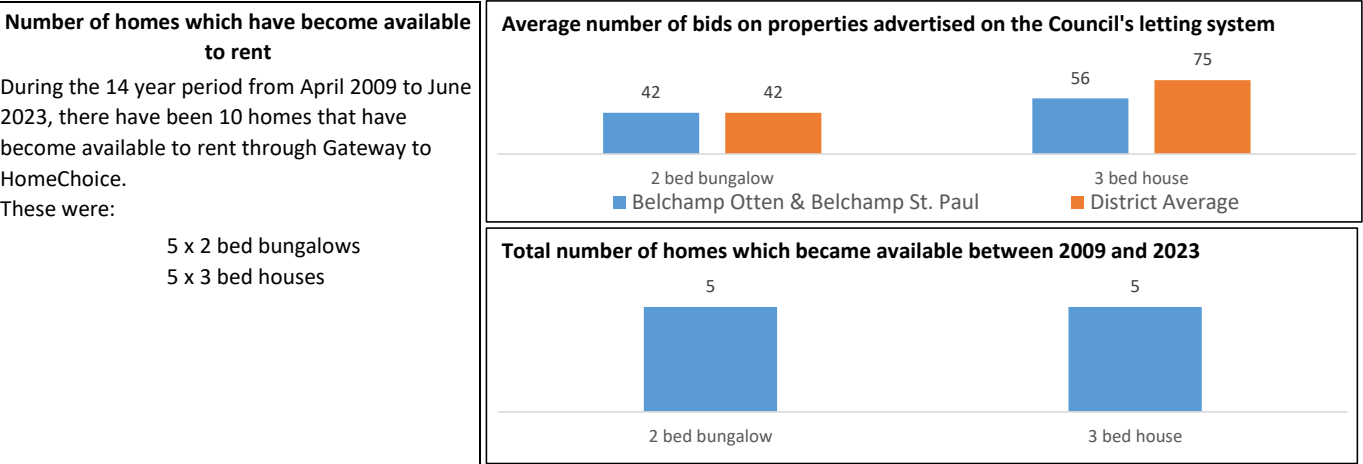
